

## JANUARY 2025 MYSTERY QUILT FABRIC REQUIREMENTS AND SUPPLY LIST

- \*\* This quilt starts with a focal fabric that should have at least 3 or 4 colors in it. You will be pulling the colors from it for the other fabrics and fussy cutting the centers of blocks if you want.
- \*\* This focal fabric should also be the outside border if you want the largest size.
- \*\* There are 2 choices depending on how many borders you add.
  - ^ Size A finishes at 53" square and will have **ONE** mitered border that contains part of the design
  - ^ Size B finishes at 60" square with **TWO** mitered borders adding one more border to the 53" quilt

FABRIC #	FABRIC DESCRIPTION	SIZE A - 9 BLOCKS 15" SQUARE WITH ONE BORDER	SIZE B - 9 BLOCKS 15" SQUARE WITH TWO BORDERS
#1	Focal fabric - This fabric should have at least 3 or 4 colors in it and can be an overall design or something you might want to fussy cut for the center of the two different blocks	14" or .4 M <b>MORE</b> if fussy cutting	43" or 1.2 M <b>MORE</b> if fussy cutting and this includes the second mitered border
#2	Medium toned fabric from one of the colors in your focal fabric	14" or .4 M <b>PLUS</b> 27" or .7 M for first border with mitered corners <b>NOTE:</b> Or the border can come from Fabric #3 below	14" or .4 M <b>PLUS</b> 27" or .7 M for first border with mitered corners <b>NOTE:</b> Or the border can come from Fabric #3 below
#3	Another medium toned fabric from one of the colors in your focal fabric	18" or .5 M <b>PLUS</b> the extra above if you want this for the first border	18" or .5 M <b>PLUS</b> the extra above if you want this for the first border
#4	Dark toned fabric from one of the colors in your focal fabric	39" or 1 M <b>PLUS</b> 20" or .5 M for binding	39" or 1 M <b>PLUS</b> 20" or .5 M for binding
#5	Background fabric - a tone on tone or pale fabric to go with your selection of fabrics. <b>NOTE</b> that white might be a bit stark depending on the value of your other colors	42" or 1.1 M	42" or 1.1 M
#6 <b>OPTIONAL</b>	One other fabric color you might like to use as a small accent to coordinate with your fabrics. If not, these pieces are cut from Fabric 4 and the yardage is already included there.	1 WOF strip of fabric 2-3/8" wide	1 WOF strip of fabric 2-3/8" wide

### SUPPLY LIST

- ^ Sewing machine, foot pedal & cords
- ^ 6" X 12" ruler (a **MUST** for trimming)
- ^ Small (12" X 18") cutting mat (**OPTIONAL**)
- ^ Measuring tape
- ^ Coordinating thread for your project
- ^ Rotary cutter
- ^ 1/2" wide ruler for marking HST lines (**OPTIONAL**)
- ^ pins and other regular sewing accessories of your choice
