

### **Sammy The Scarecrow's Fall Fun**

Wall Hanging approximately 21" long by 17" wide

Featuring fusible appliqué and beautiful 3-D fabric flowers

The three dimensional flowers make this wall hanging extra special! Have fun learning how to make these 'blooming beauties'. The texture adds a lot of interest which makes this quilt outstanding! These instructions assume basic knowledge of quilting, sewing, cutting, and piecing.

#### **Supply List:**

Non-permanent fabric pen/pencil- light and dark

Threads to match fabric

22" by 18" Pellon TP971F fusible fleece or quilt batting

22" by 18" Pellon P44F Light weight fusible interfacing or favorite stabilizer

1 yard Heat 'N Bond Lite paper back fusible

Bits of wool or twine for Scarecrow's hair and tufts on corn

Small amount of black embroidery thread

Small beads for black bird's eyes, I used transparent green

#### **Fabric List: Note- one way design may require more yardage**

**Tone on tone fabrics work well for flowers**

21" by 17" blue sky background  
22" by 18" backing fabric  
1/4 yard dark blue binding  
13" by 9" light brown straw Scarecrow's Hat  
fat quarter small plaid scarecrow's shirt  
12" by 12" navy scarecrow's overalls  
12" by 12" scarecrow's kerchief  
fat quarter scarecrow's face and small flowers  
6" by 6" golden yellow, yo-yo burgundy flowers centers  
13" by 13" green cornstalks, hat band, pumpkin stems  
5" by 5" corn fabric for corncobs  
6" by 6" black birds  
3" by 3" dark grey bird wings  
7" by 7" **two** pieces orange- one for each pumpkin  
fat quarter burgundy flowers  
1/4 yard brown sunflower centers, I used a batik \* need full width to cut strips  
1/3 yard yellow sunflower petals  
5" by 5" green yo-yo flower centers for cream flowers  
scraps pink, orange, black- scarecrow's cheeks, nose and eyes
