

Scrappy Modern Medallions

31" x 31"

This class **features improvisational patchwork and a unique applique method** which makes multiple applique shapes at once, FAST! The appliques turn under the raw edges, all by themselves. The potential for this technique is mind blowing! We will use water soluble thread, water soluble glue and stabilizer to make this project. All techniques are designed to make this project fast, fun and easy!

Before class:

Choose your colour palette before coming to class. If you are unsure about your choices, we will go over the options in class.

Refer to a colour wheel to help make choices. Choose 3 to 4 colours that are beside each other on the colour wheel.

For example I chose yellow, green and blue. Add all the colours in between those three colours, blends of, such as lime, chartreuse, turquoise and teal.

To get started sorting you might as well sort ALL your scraps by colour.

Once sorted, you can pick 3 or 4 colours for this project

Colour group examples as seen on a colour wheel:

Yellow, green, blue

yellow, orange, red

Blue, purple, fuchsia

Orange, yellow, green

Green, blue, purple

Supply List:

Sewing machine with 1/4" foot

Your fabulous fabric scraps (fat quarters are welcome too)

New Microtex 80/12 machine needle for piecing (or your favourite)

Neutral colour piecing thread – like 50wt Aurifil to coordinate with your fabric colour palette

.60 metre background fabric

1 fat quarter for bias tape making, coordinate with scraps. This will be the large circle holding all the petals and binding

1/2" bias tape maker (loaners available)

Blue wash away marker

Ruler, cutting mat and rotary cutter, a small set is suitable

Seam Align Gentle Hold Fabric glue (loaners available)

Your favourite fabric stabilizer or starch (I used Easy Press)

Water Soluble Glue

Wool Pressing Mat if you have one
