

“Terry’s Magic Block” Stained Glass Technique Class Supply List

What You Will Need

Before we begin, let's gather the materials you'll need:

- **Fussy Cut Blocks:** Select a couple of blocks with designs that you love.
- (butterflies- flowers-eye spy images ,etc)
- these blocks can range in size 2 ½” to 8” and can be squares or rectangles
- I would bring 4-8 pieces (I like to have two per block
- **Coordinating Scraps:** Choose fabric scraps that complement your fussy cut blocks.
- A gallon size bag of various sizes of scraps
- squares , rectangles, strips ranging from 2 ½’ to 8”
- **Black Fabric Strips:** This will simulate the lead in stained glass. **(you can use whatever color you want for your sashings)**
- Approx ½ yard which will be cut in 1” strips
- **Small 15” design board** I have a video on making one out of cardboard and flannel

- **Rotary Cutter , Cutting Mat ,Ruler** a small mat 12”x 18” next to you, as well as a small ruler I like my 3” x 12” ruler for making the blocks
- If you have a 12 ½” square up ruler bring it also...do not buy one I will have one in class.
- **normal sewing supplies** pins, scissors, thread, bobbins. I like using the color of your grout lines- pre wind a couple of bobbins.
- **Sewing Machine - extension cords**
